#### OLD BUSINESS -

- 1. 139 Inspection Software- IT staff is working on finishing base map for airport, will set up a meeting soon to roll out software.
- 2. Replacement regulator for 03/21. Discussion on bravo regulator issues from previous month. After last month board meeting, the regulator for 03/21 failed, the electrician came in and we were able to bypass regulator and disable pilot control. The regulator for both 03/21 and Bravo are almost 20 years old and have been failing for years. Tim asked the board to approve 10,900.00 for a new ADB regulator to replace the aging regulator in the vault. The purchase of this regulator will be able to power the new LED lighting when installed. Andrew discussed the possibility of funding for the lighting, Jason has had a few discussions with the FAA and INDOT about funding availability this year to begin replacing the lights as soon as

possible to LED. This Runway is direct buried and wiring issues are difficulty to trouble shoot and difficult to repair.

A motion to approve the purchase of the new ADB regulator for \$10,900.00 was made by Dr.Alexander, and  $2^{nd}$  By Mike Concannon to approve the Purchase of the Regulator for 03/21

- 3. Rickenbaucher tour- John and Tim went on the tour of the tower at Rickenbaucher, very nice tower and nice equipment.

  Tim and John are going to research more, look into some options and work with Jason on coming up with a bid process.
- 4. Tim Discussed the FAA cost share analysis B/C ration, this is what determines what we currently pay to have the tower staffed. The Authority pays a 2/3 and the City and County Split 1/3. This will lower the obligations from all.

## **New Business**

Jeff Huff From Star Bank was here tonight to discuss financials, and future investments. Discussion on the restrictions on investing municipal funds. Jeff Discussed the investment policy and Indiana Codes. Asked the board about what the plan or vision was. Ron asked questions about criteria. Jeff discussed percent of investible assets, up to 2 years no more than 75% (0-24months), 25% can be extended (25-60 months). The board will have to discuss how much they want to invest and then research the best option. Tim cautioned about investing long term with the need for cash flow for upcoming projects, based on reimbursement from FAA and INDOT. At some point Jeff would bring Doug from Star to discuss investment options. Tim will work with Cathy the Accountant to research previous years investments. Ron discussed rates that he has seen and would like to investigate more.
