## **OLD BUSINESS -**

## Management

Tim advised the board that the farmer has not maintained any of the unplanted fields. The weeds are getting taller and will potentially pose a wildlife hazard. Per the farm Lease he is responsible for spraying and controlling the weeds. Tim asked the attorney to prepare and submit a letter declaring him in default of the contract on weed and payment.

Tim discussed with the board that he has received some interest in developing some of the land for solar use. Tim asked if this was something that the board was interested in pursuing and the board agreed that if someone was interested that they would entertain a proposal of the project. Tim will forward this back to Brad Bookout at the County for further investigation of interest.

# **ENGINEER-**

Runway 03/21 and TwY B Lighting Rehab

Project pre final inspection held on June 27 with Indot and AFC and punch list was issued Work remaining was primarily clean up, grading touch up and seeding. They were on site 7/1 to begin this effort.

As mentioned in earlier meeting, AFC found some existing electrical duct banks that after a day's effort to re-use, could not. A new duct bank was installed. Change order #1- Final Balancing has been prepared. The total of the additions and under-runs results in a net increase of \$27, 435.75 or 3.4% of the total contract Paul requested for a motion to approve Change Order #1- Final with AFC for the above amount.

A motion was made by Mike Concannon to approve Change order #1 in the above amount , and  $2^{nd}$  Rhonda Small .

Runway 14/32 Rehab Phase 2 Drainage Improvements project is expected to begin on July 22<sup>nd</sup> with a completion date on or before August 8<sup>th</sup>. A preconstruction meeting was held with 3D construction on June 27<sup>th</sup>. All materials have been submitted and reviewed.

Jet Ramp- Concrete Pavement Joint Sealing- Huff sealing was planning on starting later in July, However they contacted airport last week and had an opening to start today. They hope for a duration of 5-6 days.

FY 2019 Project- The FAA grant application was submitted. The FAA has had some questions and revisions we have worked through. Still working through questions regarding the environmental component.
